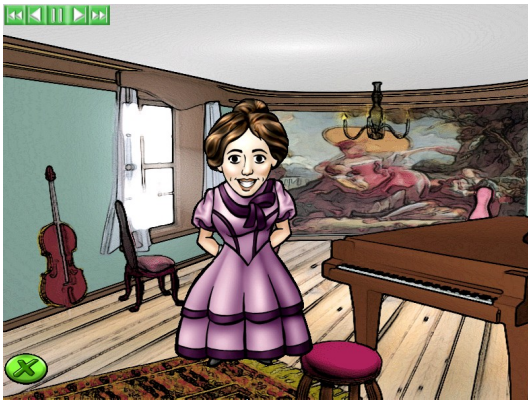




Lesson 16
