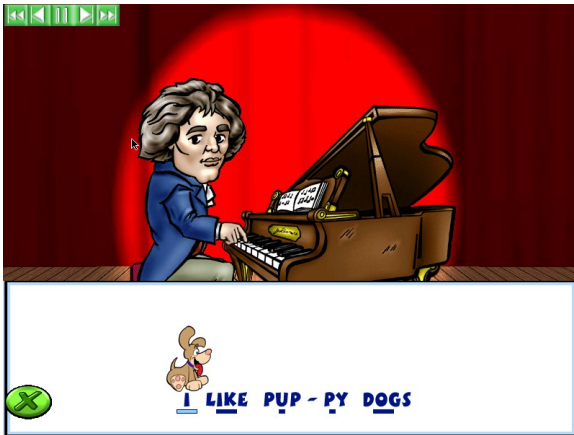




Lesson 3
